XML API 10.0.0 SP4 and 9.0.0 SP7 Enhancements

XML API 10.0.0SP4 for WBS31
XML API 9.0.0SP7 for WBS30

Dear WebEx API Developer:

This notification applies to your integrations for **WBS 31 (XML API 10.0.0SP4)** and **WBS 30 (XML API 9.0.0 SP7)**.

A set of XML API enhancements will be applied to your production WebEx site between **June 16, 2016 and June 26, 2016**.

All features will be **backward compatible** with your existing integrations. This communication is to serve as an informational update.

The XML API schemas and release notes will be available at the Cisco WebEx Developer Portal:

If you have a **development site** as part of the Gold Developer Program, the API enhancements will be applied to them a few days in advance of being deployed to the production sites between **June 8, 2016 and June 9, 2016**. Please perform regression testing after this deployment.

New Features for API version - (XML API 10.0.0SP4 ONLY)

#1 User preferences for default Global Call-in numbers will be supported via APIs**Description:**

A Site admin can enable users to set their preferred global call-in numbers from a subset of numbers available at the site level. In this release, *setUser* API has been enhanced to allow a user or a site admin on behalf of user to set two preferred global call-in numbers.

*Note: GetSite APIs can be used to get a site level list of supported call-in numbers (country aliases) *this is already supported.*

#2 New Guest API to obtain Personal Meeting Room details for other users**Description:**

A new API is introduced to obtain public information for a personal meeting room for other users. This API does not require authentication. With WebEx site and personal room id, email address or WebEx id as inputs, this API returns basic Personal Room information including avatars and Personal Room URL.

#3 Support Link added to welcome emails sent from CreateUser API

Description:

A new support link will be added to all emails sent when a user is provisioned. The link leads to training and help information on how to schedule and manage meetings.
